Familiarize yourself with the selected articles in the <u>CBA</u> that you are creating guidelines for: Performance Evaluations [<u>Article 18</u>], Evaluations for Library Faculty [<u>Article 19</u>], Tenure [<u>Article 20</u>], Promotions for Tenure-Earning and Tenured Faculty [<u>Article 21</u>], Promotions for Library Faculty [<u>Article 22</u>], Promotions for Instructors and Lecturers [<u>Article 23</u>], Promotions for Clinical Faculty [<u>Article 24</u>].

Consider <u>guidelines</u> that have been accepted by other departments and approved by the administration.

Examine both the *academic standards* and *required evidence* provided for in the articles that you are creating guidelines for and clarify them as described for your own discipline and department.
