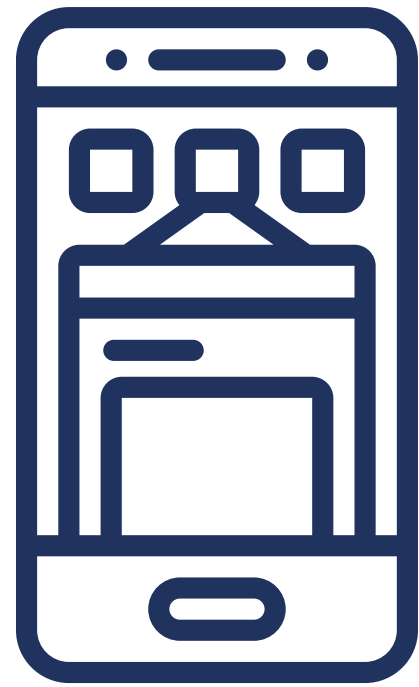

Wear a face mask

Whenever on campus, wear a cloth face mask that covers your nose and mouth.



Get vaccinated

Stay home

If you test positive, have been exposed to the virus and are unvaccinated, stay home. Follow appropriate HR policies for requesting time off.

Get tested
